Garvin Heights Overlook

Spectacular views of the Winona area and Mississippi River Valley from this park 545 feet above sea level. Don't forget your camera!



Tundra Swan Watch

Join our guides from the Upper Mississippi Wildlife & Fish Refuge on a day trip to view the tundra swans in their favorite spots.

Christmas Art Walk

Visit various studios, galleries and stores in town to visit with artists and purchase their arts and crafts.



Museums

Visit the MN Marine Art Museum, Polish Museum, Watkins Museum, Winona County Historical Society Museum (including Arches Museum and Bunnell House), Pickwick Mill, and Rollingsstone Luxembourg Heritage Museum.

Candlelight House Tour

Beautifully decorated and lit homes are open for viewing as a fund-raiser for the Winona County Historical Society.

Holiday Lighted Parade

Get into the holiday mood with this festive event that switches between Winona and Goodview.

Voice from the Past Cemetery Discovery Walk

Journey into Winona's colorful past as volunteers portray some of the city's interesting residents who are now buried at Woodlawn Cemetery.

Frozen River Film Festival

This event features films, speakers, workshops and demonstrations with a focus on environment, adventure, extreme sports and world culture.
